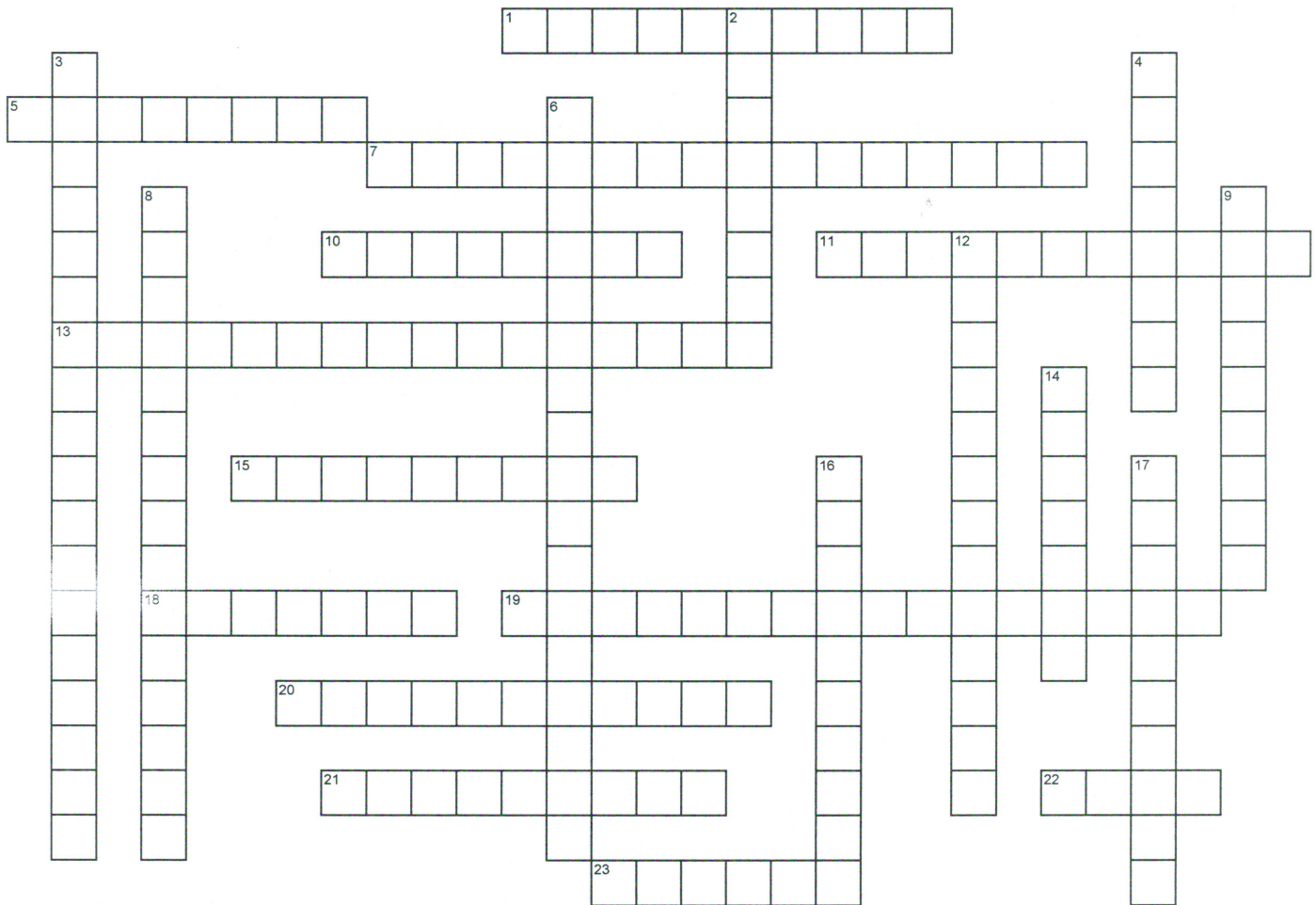


Unit 1: Intro to Geography



ACROSS

- 1 A change in the shape, size, or position of a place when it is shown on a map
- 5 Any natural feature of Earth's surface that has a distinct shape
- 7 Any action that relates to the making, buying, and selling of goods and services
- 10 Run east to west on a map
- 11 A map that shows a particular theme, or topic
- 13 The precise point where a place is located on Earth
- 15 Height above sea level
- 18 Parallel of latitude that circles the Earth exactly midway between the North and South poles
- 19 Where a place is located in relation to another place
- 20 Direction-finding tool that resembles a flower
- 21 Meridian lines that run from the North Pole to the South Pole
- 22 Imaginary line running from the North Pole to the South Pole through the center of the Earth
- 23 An area defined by one or more natural or cultural characteristics that set it apart from other areas

- 2 Spinning motion of the Earth
- 3 The directions of North, South, East, and West
- 4 Provides information on the distance on a map
- 6 The average number of people who live in a unit of area
- 8 Any natural characteristics of Earth's surface, such as landforms or bodies of water
- 9 Also known as a map key, this identifies symbols used on a map
- 12 A way of representing the spherical Earth on a flat surface
- 14 The pattern of weather over a long period of time
- 16 all the plants and trees in an area
- 17 One round trip of the Earth around the sun
